Rules

The current IBU event and competition rules will be in effect for the event. Any modifications to the rules will be discussed at the team captains meeting.

Eligibility

Any member of USBA or Biathlon Canada, in good standing, may participate in this event. Please have current registration card or number at registration.

Awards

Awards will be presented as follows:

1. If there are four or more competitors in a class the top three will receive gold, silver and bronze medals
2. If there are three competitors in a class the top two will receive gold and silver medals
3. If there are two competitors in a class only the gold medal will be awarded

Cash prizes will be awarded for the **IBU Senior Class** as follows:

First place: \$200

Second place: \$100

Third place: \$50

FKOC classes (Masters and U17 and U15) will be awarded non-cash prizes.

Entry

Fees: One (1) competition: U17 and under USD \$25; All other classes USD \$35
Two (2) competitions: U17 and under USD \$50; All other classes USD \$70

Deadline: All entries must be received by 1200 noon on Wednesday, January 25th.

***No same day registrations will be accepted.**
